Medical Professionals:

In 2021 our medical team needs to grow. Clearly the need for our services will increase as the world continues to spiral into more and more sin and lawlessness. The center needs to be open more days a week and we need to train a minimum of two more ultrasound technicians to accomplish this goal.
